For over three decades, Keith Bowers has been at the forefront of applied ecology, land conservation and sustainable design. As the founder and president of Biohabitats, Keith has built a multidisciplinary organization of scientists, engineers, landscape architects and natural resource planners. His work has spanned the scales of site-specific ecosystem restoration projects involving wetland, river, woodland and coastal habitat restoration to regional watershed management and species conservation planning, to that of green infrastructure and urban ecology planning for cities.
