To whom it may concern,

I was contracted to evaluate the health of an 18" Laurel Oak tree at 313 Station 30, Sullivan's Island, SC. The tree is located in the front left area of the property, to the direct right of the driveway. My evaluation was completed from the ground.

I found the oak to be in poor condition. This tree has a co-dominant stem at seven feet, with decay in the lower half. The large bulge found at the division of stems indicates an excessive amount of included bark. Coupling the decay and included bark, this would be considered a very weak attachment. Dieback was evident in the crown, at about 40%. Due to the poor structure of the tree and its current dieback, arborist intervention is not recommended.
