



## TOWN OF SULLIVAN'S ISLAND APPLICATION FOR TEMPORARY POWER SERVICES

### TEMPORARY POWER OWNER AFFIDAVIT

Section R 107.3 of the International Residential Code allows issuance of temporary power for testing of stems and the facilitate installation of products associated with or to be construed as permission to occupy a structure.

I, \_\_\_\_\_, property owner of \_\_\_\_\_ understand that the approval of temporary power does not allow for the occupancy of the building. I agree to provide all necessary documentation and complete all necessary final inspections for a Certificate of Occupancy/Completion within \_\_\_\_\_ days of approval of temporary power. I agree that no furniture will be moved into the structure until the Certificate of Occupancy/Completion has been issued. If the structure is NOT in compliance within the requested timeframe an extension may be requested by the owner or the contractor. Failure to extend or comply with this agreement will result in the termination of electrical service without any notification to the homeowner, electrician, or builder. The issuance of a Certificate of Occupancy/Completion shall be considered approval of permanent power and permission to occupy the structure.

The Town of Sullivan's Island and/or Dominion Energy will not be held responsible for any damages caused by the termination of power from the residence.

PLEASE NOTE: Power maybe terminated at any time if an electrical safety issue is found on the property per section R107.4 of the IRC.
