PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, it has been determined that Tropical Storm Debby is occurring in close proximity to the coast of South Carolina and threatens to disrupt the normal activities of the community within the corporate limits of the Town of Sullivan's Island; and,

WHEREAS, Governor Henry McMaster declared a State of Emergency for the State of South Carolina under Executive Order Number 2024-16 on August 4, 2024; and,

WHEREAS, accordingly a state of emergency does in fact exist.

NOW THEREFORE, I, Patrick O'Neil, by virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of the Town of Sullivan's Island, do proclaim a State of Emergency and invoke the provisions of Section 30-22 of the Code of Ordinances for the Town of Sullivan's Island, South Carolina.

AND, FURTHERMORE, any emergency ordinance adopted or enacted by Charleston County Council pursuant to the Council's Declaration of Emergency related to Tropical Storm Debby shall be applicable to and enforceable within the corporate limits of the Town of Sullivan's Island. All law enforcement officers of the County or State are authorized to enforce any such Emergency Ordinance within the Town's Corporate limits.
