THURSDAY, JULY 4TH EVENT REMINDERS & RULES

Welcome to the Sullivan's Island Independence Day Golf Cart & Bicycle Parade. This event brings together neighbors to kick-off of the holiday with a chance to show your patriotic pride, a little friendly/neighborly golf cart/bicycle decoration competition and a family friendly celebration at the parade's end.

The Town hopes everyone enjoys a fun and safe celebration. With that goal in mind, please note the following event "rules:"

- 1. Parade is designed for golf-carts and bicycles. Motorized vehicles are not included and all parade participants should expect to ride or bicycle, not walk.
- 2. Decorate your golf cart or bicycle (optional but encouraged) off-site (not at parade site) and be ready to start at line-up.
- 3. Line up by 8:30AM at SI Elementary School. Parade starts at 9:00AM Parade route: SI Elementary School to Fish Fry Shack (finale)
- 4. Golf cart prizes shall include 1st, 2nd & 3rd place winners with optional Honorable Mentions. An award will be given for best bicycle decoration. Judges will include Council members of the Recreation Committee and all decisions are final.
- 5. You must be present during the finale celebration to win an award. Otherwise, judges will issue award to runner-up participants who are present.
- 6. Please, no profane or distasteful decorations or you will be asked to leave this family-oriented parade.
- 7. No alcohol allowed
- 8. Children must be under adult supervision at all times
- 9. Children are encouraged to bring their own water guns for the finale celebration
