Station 28 ½ Traffic Detour beginning March 16, 2026.

Beginning on March 16, 2026, there will be a road closure around Middle Street and Station 28 ½ to install new drainage infrastructure.

For approximately six weeks, local traffic will be permitted access around barricades installed at eastbound lanes on Middle Street and Station 28 ½, and westbound lanes on Middle and Station 28 ½. Like previous traffic detours for this project, all residents will have access to their properties. All vehicles (delivery trucks, school busses, solid waste collection etc.) will be allowed access around the “Road Closed to Thru Traffic” signage. A map is available on our website.
