Homeowners Laurie Ulmer and Dawn Ulmer gave an update on the incident that happened in their garage regarding a drain blockage/sewer backup caused by a grouting operation back in November of 2018. Mr. Ulmer stated that the Town and Bionomics denied responsibility. After reviewing photos and emails provided by the Ulmer's, Chair Smith stated he would like to see more correspondence and emails with time stamps. This item will be discussed in more detail at the next meeting.
